Theology of the Body Sessions for Middle School Students (Grade 6-8):

September 26, October 3, October 17, October 24, November 7, November 14, November 21
6:15-7:30 in the School and includes a pizza dinner for students. The cost of the series is \$25 for the first student and \$15 for each additional student.

Theology of the Body answers the questions middle school students may have about sexual morality, relationships, and how they were uniquely created for greatness. The program uses a dynamic mix of stories, real-life examples, activities, prayers, and relevant references to the culture, all packed into seven life-changing lessons. Middle schoolers and a parent should attend the sessions. Students and their parents meet at the same time in different locations to discuss each chapter separately, then come together in conversation with questions from a parent's guide. This program is optional, but highly recommended.
